FIELD TRIAL DOG CLASS - A Class for Dogs that have a placement at a licensed or member AKC Field Trial and/or hold one of the AKC Hunt Test Titles (JH, SH, or MH) and/or hold the English Setter Association of America HD or HDX Title or Hunting Test Title.

FIELD TRIAL BITCH CLASS - A Class for Dogs that have a placement at a licensed or member AKC Field Trial and/or hold one of the AKC Hunt Test Titles (JH, SH, or MH) and/or hold the English Setter Association of America HD or HDX Title or Hunting Test Title.

STUD DOG CLASS - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog Class, the Get **MUST** be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

BROOD BITCH CLASS - Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Effective January 1, 2010

CHAPTER 11, SECTION 1.

No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book, or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration.

See <http://www.akc.org/pdfs/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf> for complete detail of the rule change.

Attention Exhibitors

1. The Show Site will be available to exhibitors from 8:00 am to 10:00 pm on Thursday, August 13, 2009. The site will again be available at 6:00 am on Friday, August 14, 2009, Saturday, August 15, 2009 & Sunday, August 16, 2009. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging on Sunday, August 16, 2009.
2. **NO VEHICLES WILL BE ALLOWED TO ENTER THE PARK BETWEEN 10:00 PM & 6:00 AM. NO DOGS OUT OF VEHICLES BETWEEN 11:00 PM & 6:00 AM.**
3. The show-giving club reserves the right to run two group rings simultaneously.
4. No generators to operate within 100 feet of any ring during judging times.
5. **THERE SHALL BE NO DRILLING NOR INTENSIVE OR ABUSIVE TRAINING OF DOGS ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.**
6.

GKC RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REMOVE ANY ANIMAL IN DISTRESS FROM A PARKED VEHICLE OR CRATE ANY WAY NECESSARY. GKC SOLELY DETERMINES IF SAID ANIMAL IS IN DISTRESS. ALL PERSONS ATTENDING THIS DOG SHOW HEREBY WAIVE ANY CLAIM FOR DAMAGES AGAINST THE CLUB FOR SUCH REMOVAL.

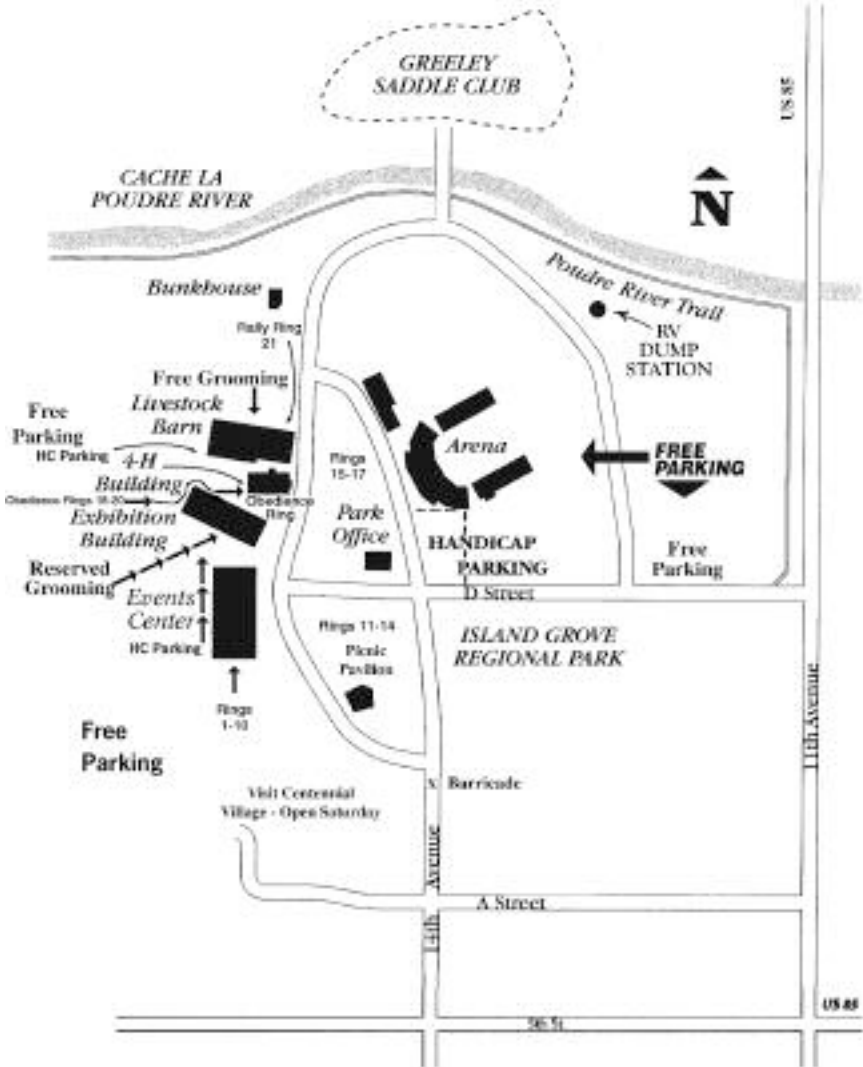

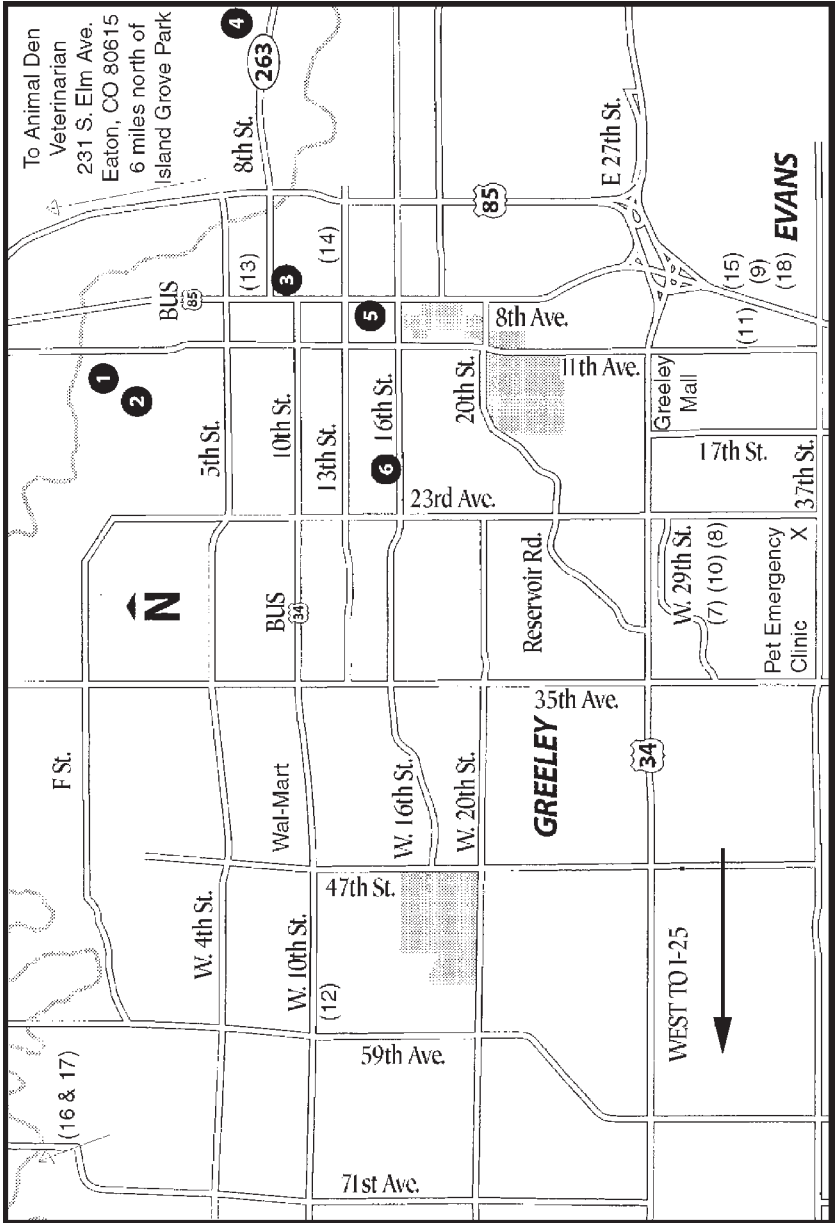
