NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES Involving Single Dog Entries

FIELD TRIAL DOG CLASS - A Class for Dogs that have placed first, second, third or fourth in an AKC licensed or member field trial.

FIELD TRIAL BITCH CLASS - A Class for Bitches that have placed first, second, third or fourth in an AKC licensed or member field trial.

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES Involving Multiple Dog Entries

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

STUD DOG CLASS - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but MUST be entered in the Stud Dog Class, the Get MUST be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

BROOD BITCH CLASS - Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

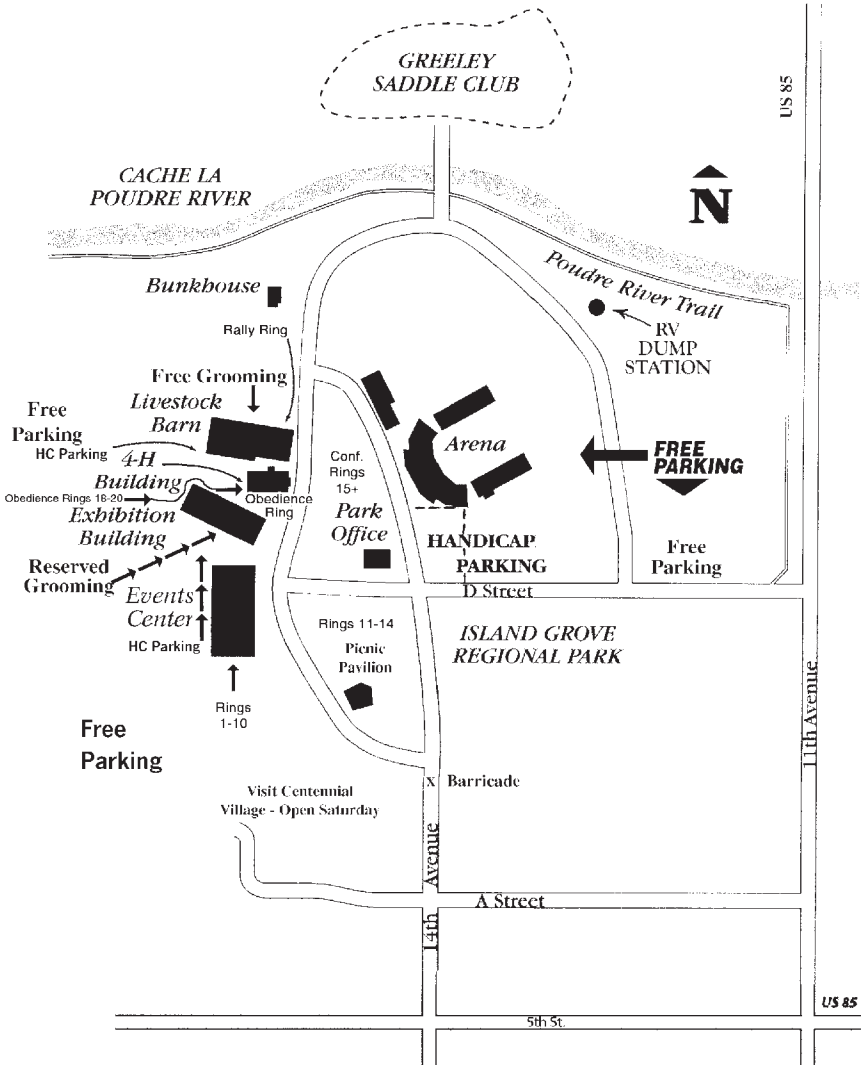

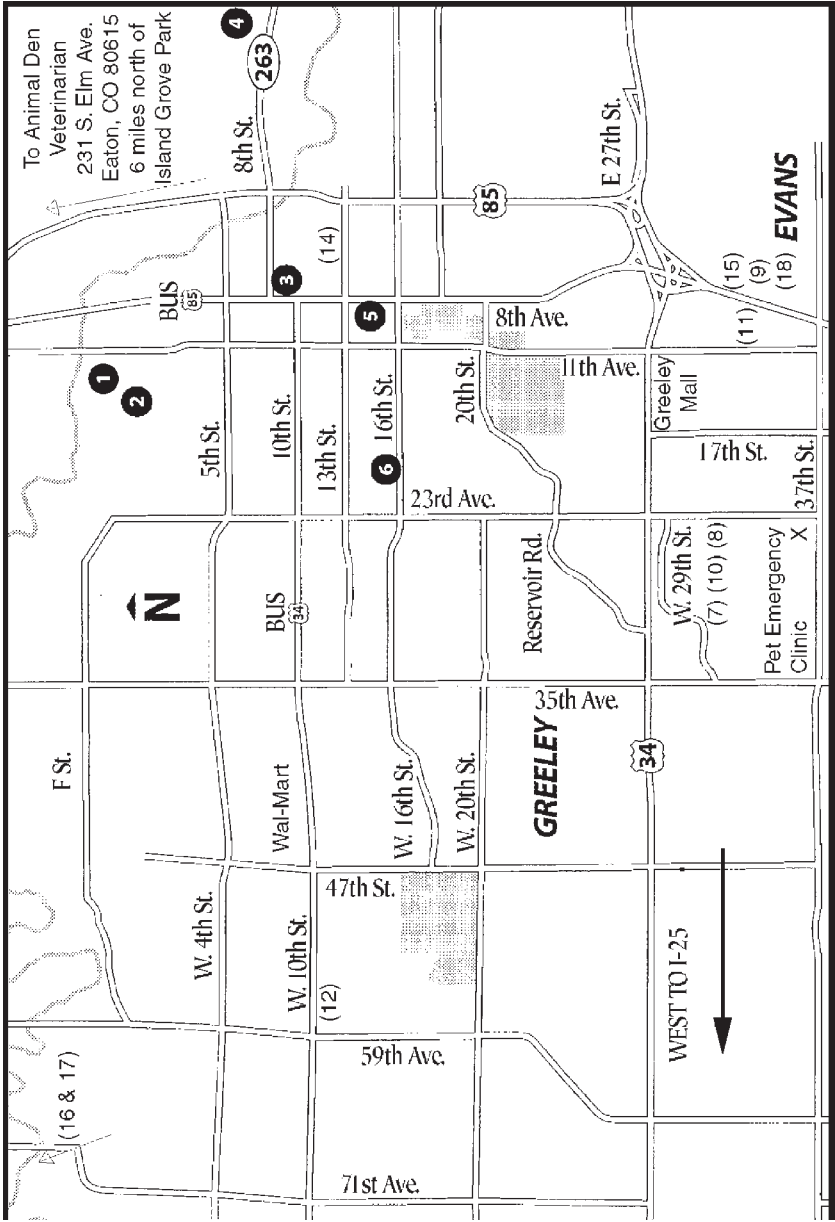

FOR ISLAND GROVE PARK SPECIALTIES & ALL-BREED SHOWS

THE ONLY ENTRANCE INTO THE SHOW SITE WILL BE OFF 11TH AVE (14th Ave will be closed at "B" St from Wednesday through Sunday, August 17-21, 2011).

LOADING & UNLOADING AREAS: 20 MINUTE TIME LIMIT. Please do not leave vehicles unattended. Vehicles in no parking, fire lanes or 20 ft from a fire hydrant will be ticketed or towed at the owner's expense.

DAY PARKING: The paved lot south of the stadium (approx one block from the show building) is available for day parking. There are no electrical hookups in this lot. Additional day parking is available **FREE OF CHARGE** on the east side of the park & west of the show buildings. These are gravel lots. RV Sites that are not filled by Saturday at 7:00 am to Best in Show may be used as Day Parking. All RV s must be in their site by Friday at 8:00 pm.

All of the south side of D Street (see map on page 12) from the Event Center to loading and unloading areas will be overnight reservation parking only. (No more day parking on that part of D ST).
